- Grad fees which partially cover gown rental, facility rental and events.

Certificates of Graduation

DOGWOOD DIPLOMA

The BC Certificate of Graduation of "Dogwood Diploma" is awarded to students who successfully complete the provincial graduation requirements. To graduate, they require at least 80 credits total.

EVERGREEN

The School Completion "Evergreen" Certificate is intended to celebrate success in learning that is not recognized in the "Dogwood Diploma." It is used to recognize the accomplishments of students with special needs and Individual Education Plans (IEP's) who have met the goals of their program

The evergreen certificate is NOT a graduation credential; students who receive Evergreen have NOT graduated. SD22 has a process to determine if this is an appropriate path for a student to take.

Other Graduation Credits

Alternative ways to receive credits are through Independent Studies, The Academy of Inquiry and Adventure, and Career Duo Credit Programs such as NICU, Forestry, Automotive Repair, Administrative Assistant, and so much more.
